

## Oriole Park Player Contract

I do hereby agree to abide by the **OPYF Player Contract Code of Conduct** as well as to the discretionary authority given to all authorized coaches in the program. Failure to follow the code or coach's instruction will be deemed grounds for disciplinary action and/or dismissal from the team.

1. I will attend all scheduled practices and games. If I'm unable to do so, I will contact my coach or team-mom beforehand by phone or email.
2. If I have an **unexcused** absence, it will result in a loss of playing time.
3. If you have **two unexcused** absences, it will result in not playing in that week's game.
4. If I have **Multiple** absences, it will result in a loss of playing time.
5. Players arriving late or leaving early without prior notification will result in loss of playing time.
6. Players not properly equipped for a game or practice may be required to run laps and / or resulting loss of playing time.
7. I will respect all coaches at all times, calling them **Coach or Mr. Last Name.**
8. I will work hard in school maintaining a "C" or higher grade.
9. I will respect and obey my parents.
10. I will respect referees, players (team/opponent) and coaches at all times.
11. I will have sportsmanship as my number one priority in all games and practices.
12. I will conduct myself in a way that presents a positive image of the OPYF and myself on and off the field.
13. If I have an unsportsmanlike event, it will result in my immediate removal from the game and a one game suspension.
14. I will not use profanity
15. I will encourage my teammates in a positive way, regardless of the circumstances.
16. I will return all equipment at the year's end or immediately upon dismissal from the team.
17. Fighting:
  - a. First offense: suspension for one game and one week of practice
  - b. Second offense: suspension and parental/guardian conference.
18. Disrespect for coaches, participants, game and team officials.
  - a. First offense: removal from game and parental/guardian conference.
  - b. Second offense: suspension for one game and one week of practice.
  - c. Third offense: suspension and parental/guardian conference.

19. Badgering opponents and/or teammates by word or act with the purpose of intimidation.
  - a. First offense: removal from game/practice and parental/guardian conference.
  - b. Second offense: suspension for one game and one week of practice.
  - c. Third offense: suspension and parental/guardian conference.
