The Oriole Park Youth Football Program has a history of providing a positive sportsmanship environment for our players. Our program is bigger than any one player, coach or spectator.

1. Encourage members of both teams.
2. Keep all comments positive.
3. Only players and coaches are allowed on the field.
4. Leave the coaching to the coaches
5. Criticizing the officials, coaches, players, opponents, and OPYF volunteers/board members will not be tolerated.
6. You are responsible for all family members and friends attending the games to watch your child.
7. Help make this a positive and fun experience for all.
8. Report any violations to a board member. Do not confront but get involved.
9. A 24-hour cool down period will take place after an incident/complaint before approaching a coach or board member. ***Please do this away from the children.***

Policy Enforcement

1. Individual will be given a warning for inappropriate behavior.
2. Individuals that continue, will be asked to leave the field and the player removed from the game until that spectator has left.
3. Other sanctions as deemed necessary by the board may be enforced, including permanent ban.
4. All decisions will be final. **NO APPEALS!!!**
5. Physical confrontations: suspension for the remainder of the season and subject to arrest.
6. First offense: removal from the game/practice and OPYF board conference
7. Second offense: removal from the game/practice and following weeks practice and game.
8. Third offense: suspension for the season.
